Snufflemat Nhat you need



- 12" x 15" rubber sink mat with holes*
- Light to medium weight fleece (approx. 1.5 yards)*; more than one color for fun!
- Scissors or quilting mat and rotary cutter

*You can use a smaller sink mat (e.g., $12'' \times 12''$); adjust the amount of fleece accordingly.





What you do



- Cut the fleece into strips, 1" wide by 6" 7" long.
 Uniformity and precision are not important!
- 2. Push one end of a strip through the first hole on the sink mat and the other end through the neighboring hole. Tie the strip once.
- Continue down the row of holes in this manner, tying each strip in place. Then move on to the second row.
- 4. Once you have completed two rows, push a strip of fleece through the first and second holes in the first column and tie once. Push another strip through the first and second holes in the second column and tie. Continue down the two rows so that you complete the first strip for each column.



Complete the mat in this manner, tying two rows at a time and then filling in the columns.



Teach your dog to use the snufflemat by dropping pieces of kibble or treats onto the mat and letting him eat them. As he learns the game, you can push the treats deeper into the mat so he has to find them.
